No id or proof of income is required.

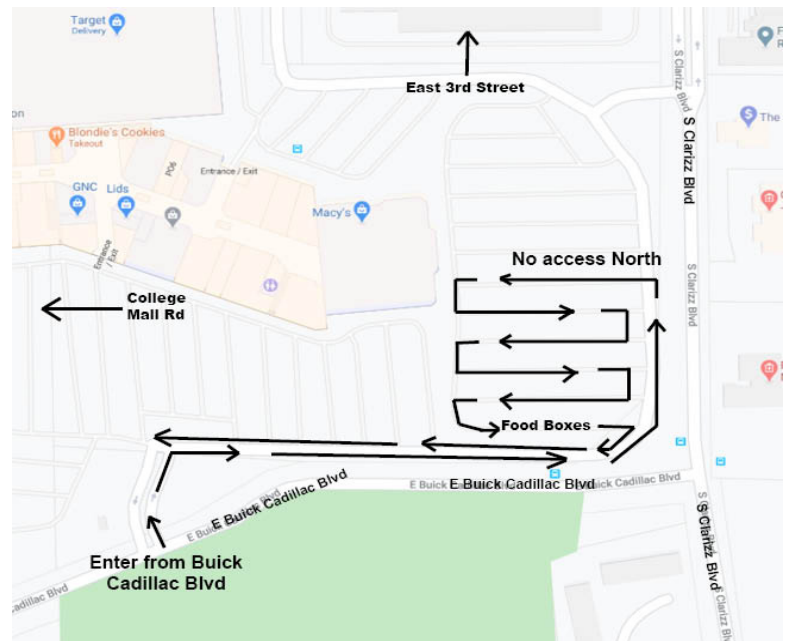

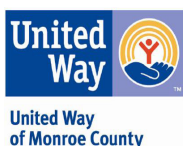
